

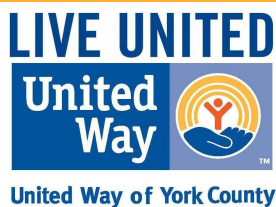

What is “EITC”, and How Does It Work?

One of the best strategies to assure a child’s readiness for school and school success is a quality early childhood education program. All children require learning opportunities in order to develop in a healthy manner. The most vulnerable children are those whose learning is impeded by

poverty, language, behavior, and developmental disabilities. They must be afforded the opportunity to receive a quality educational experience. The Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program makes pre-kindergarten opportunities available to children and families throughout

York County. Contributions, like yours, help give children throughout York County a chance at a better education. Your donation may be made to UWYC and be applied toward EITC.

How Can I Benefit?

A business may receive a tax credit equal to 100% of the first \$10,000 contributed through United Way of York County for the EITC program. Additionally they may receive a tax credit equal to

90% of any additional amount contributed during the taxable year, up to a maximum of \$200,000 of tax credits per taxable year.



What Are The Qualifications

Businesses that operate in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania qualify to participate in EITC if you are subject to the following...

- Corporate Net Income Tax
- Capital Stock Franchise Tax
- Bank and Trust Company Shares Tax
- Title Insurance Companies Shares Tax
- Insurance Premiums Tax
- Mutual Thrift Institutions Tax
- Personal Income Tax of S corporation shareholders or Partnership partners

100% of your donation will be used for education...no administrative costs will be deducted.

United Way of York County has made a commitment to reinvest the 20% allowable administrative costs into education and advancement of the teachers receiving your EITC support. This means 100% of your charitable donation to United Way of York County’s EITC program will directly benefit educational advancements.

How Do I Begin The Process To Participate?

1. Visit the website, www.newpa.com and search "EITC".
2. Click the EITC Guidelines link to download the one-page Pre-K (PKSO) application.

3. Submit to The Department of Education
4. You will be notified once approval is granted.
5. Contact Sara Bradley, Focus On Our Future Director, to talk about the amount your business was approved for, and how you can make a contribution.
6. Make a contribution to United Way of York County, Focus On Our Future.
7. Send your acknowledgement to your tax accountant.
8. Redeem your tax credits.
