In 2014, Quinton, a troubled five year old, arrived at the YMCA of York County for summer day camp after having been expelled from two previous summer programs.

Although the summer started with struggles on both Quinton's and the counselors' sides he was scheduled to attend all 10 weeks. By midsummer he showed improvements. Through the counselors' implementation of techniques learned at the National Inclusion Conference (NIC), Quinton's outbursts, tantrums and unwillingness to follow directions seen in the first half of the summer, began to become few and far between.

Without both Financial Assistance, provided by the YMCA, and the techniques learned at the NIC, Quinton's failure was imminent. With the YMCA and the improved program, Quinton was able to succeed throughout the camp day with his peers and achieved the prestigious Most Improved Camper award at the culmination of the 2014 camp season.
