York County Youth Court Alliance Scholarship – Spring 2022

Instructions & Eligibility

The Youth Court Alliance Scholarship is available for a Successful Participant or Volunteer from Northeastern, Red Lion Area, or York City school districts that will be attending an institution of higher education in the spring of 2022. The Youth Court Alliance Scholarship is \$1,000 for a college freshman through senior and \$500 per course (two courses maximum) for dual enrollment for current high school students.

A Volunteer is a student from Northeastern, Red Lion Area, and York City school districts that has completed a minimum of ten hours of community service with Youth Court Alliance within the past three years. A Successful Participant of Youth Court Alliance is a student who has completed the program successfully within the past three years.

Application and supportive materials are due by deadlines 12/10/2021.
